eMHPrac are excited to share that the Australian Government has announced \$5.3 million in funding for our project, enabling our continued efforts to raise awareness and strengthen health practitioners' knowledge and use of digital mental health services.

The funding, announced in the Mid-Year Economic and Fiscal Outlook, will enable eMHPrac to continue to expand our role in supporting Australian health practitioners to confidently integrate reputable, evidence-based digital mental health services into routine care. This is a great support to help eMHPrac provide education, free training, curated resources and implementation support to help health practitioners navigate the rapidly growing digital mental health landscape.

Since eMHPrac establishment in 2013, the project has played a critical role in building workforce capability across general practice, allied health, nursing, Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander health services, and community-based settings. The teams at Queensland University of Technology, Menzies School of Health Research, and the University for Rural Health are excited to continue this work.
